The Library Catalog is in Alphabetical Order. The common articles in front of some of the names have been eliminated to aid in the ordering process, and search process. For example, “The Adventures of Ozzie and Harriet” is “Adventures of Ozzie and Harriet”, similarly “The Adventures of Superman” is listed as “Adventures of Superman”. This will allow you to scroll through the document and not have several series all clumped under a the “The....”.

When you order an item please send the **“Final Catalog Label”** found in the last column, along with the **“Series / Recording Name”** found in the first column. Also be aware that if the word **“Collection”** appears in the fifth column, then there will be multiple tapes or CDs coming your way. Please don’t ask to borrow only one tape or cd of a collection. We want to keep the items together. If you would like to help us maintain the Library, please feel free to download the file: “Listener Notes.txt” If you fill out that form about the tape or CD you borrow and add a Title or Corrected Title, or short Synopsis, we will add that information to the Catalog with your name as the author.
